Bids may be submitted by either mail, digitally (e.g. PDF or other common read-only format), or in person by the Bidder or their agent. No late bids will be accepted.

All hard-copy bids shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name of the bidder and clearly marked "Vehicle".

Requirements of the Vendor

The Vendor {Contractor} must be a franchised and/or authorized factory representative, able to furnish the specified vehicle. Dealers or agents submitting a Quote may be required to submit a letter of certification from the manufacturer whose product is proposed, certifying that the dealer or agent is authorized by the manufacturer to supply the vehicle specified. The Authority reserves the right to request such certification and to require that such certification be delivered within five (5) working days from the time it is requested. The Vendor {Contractor} must notify the Authority {Ordering Agency} of any changes in the status of the its franchise.

The vehicle supplied must be standard manufacturer's product line, available to the general public.

A Vendor {Contractor} shall provide a new vehicle only. A used vehicle is not acceptable.

This Bid Solicitation is for the outright purchase of the vehicle only. Leasing of the vehicle or trade-in against the purchase of the vehicle is not permitted.

Any specification or requirement that cannot be confirmed by manufacturer's literature or similar documentation will be confirmed by the Using Agency prior to delivery or final acceptance.

All components of each vehicle supplied under the RFP established shall be identical, for example, alternators, filters, distributors, etc.

The Vendor {Contractor} shall be permitted to use aftermarket installers. The Vendor {Contractor} shall remain solely responsible for the equipment, installation and warranty.

The Vendor {Contractor} is responsible for ensuring aftermarket installer(s)' compliance with all terms and conditions of this Bid Solicitation. The Vendor {Contractor} will assume sole responsibility for any payments due the aftermarket installer(s).

OEM Equipment/Parts: All of the standard and optional equipment/parts provided shall be original equipment manufacturers items when available.

VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS, PART I – COMMON SPECIFICATIONS

General Information:

The Authority will utilize the manufacturer's option line to order a front license plate bracket, if offered by the vehicle manufacturer as a cost option. If the license plate bracket option is listed as a no charge option by the vehicle manufacturer, it will automatically be included as part of the base vehicle upon ordering.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The vehicle and its components shall be completely assembled, serviced and ready for use when delivered to the Ordering Agency. Unless specified otherwise; any parts, components, equipment, controls, materials, features, performances, capacities, ratings or designs which are standard and/or necessary to form an efficient and complete working vehicle shall be furnished whether specifically required herein or not. The Vendor {Contractor} shall supply any item not specified herein but deemed necessary for the intended use and the item must meet the Industry standards and practices, Federal and New Jersey Safety Standards and Regulations, and SAE and other applicable standards.

This Bid Solicitation permits published options offered by a manufacturer for a trim line and manufacturer's body code bid that is comparable.

***In circumstances, the Authority may permit the purchase of a higher trim line than what was awarded as part of the bid, by using the manufacturers options line.**

The Vendor {Contractor} must provide agencies with any delete option, such as manual transmission option, air conditioning delete option or any other delete/deduct option, through the manufacturers published options' price line (discount line); in which case, the bid discount shall be applied to a sum of purchased options' MSRP and the net result shall be deducted from the base vehicle bid. price. It is, however, expected that a purchase of manual transmission or air conditioning delete option will be rare.

The vehicle shall be delivered with at least 1/2 tank of fuel.

The vehicle furnished must be protected to -20° F, with a permanent type of anti-freeze.

All accessories shall be supplied and installed by the manufacturer. Aftermarket parts or dealer installation is permitted only if installation is not available from the manufacturer.

Manuals: The Vendor {Contractor} shall supply vehicle operation and maintenance manuals and any other manual that the vehicle manufacturer supplies as a standard manual. The Vendor {Contractor} shall deliver the manual directly to the Ordering Agency, upon delivery of the first vehicle.

Training: Complete instructions on the operation and maintenance of the vehicle and a demonstration on the operation of the vehicle shall be given by the Vendor {Contractor}, if requested by the Ordering Agency. Training must include operator training with instruction on proper operation and basic preventive maintenance of the vehicle.

Guarantee/Warranty: Advise of guarantee/warranty that can be supplied and term.

The Vendor {Contractor} shall ensure that the manufacturer, whose product is supplied, has a servicing dealer or service location to provide warranty and recall service and/or repair, located within a distance from Asbury Park, NJ, deemed to be reasonable by the Authority. The Vendor {Contractor} may use an aftermarket installer's location to satisfy service requirements, provided this is disclosed in the Quote. Any use of aftermarket installer(s) shall not relieve the Vendor {Contractor} of its obligations under the bid established as a result of this Bid Solicitation. Users of this bid should contact the Vendor {Contractor} in cases where warranty service/repair is to be performed at a place other than the original place of purchase to arrange for a servicing dealer proximate to their location.

The manufacturer's standard warranty must be supplied with the vehicle at the time of delivery and shall be in typed form. The warranty commences with the acceptance of the vehicle at the delivery site and following the final inspection.

The Vendor {Contractor} must provide complete information on warranty coverage.

DELIVERY:

The Vendor {Contractor} must make arrangements for delivery of vehicle within 15 calendar days of Vendor's {Contractor's} receipt of vehicle from the manufacturer. The vehicle must be delivered within 30 calendar days of Vendor's {Contractor's} receipt of vehicle(s) from the manufacturer. If there are extenuating circumstances the Authority may amend this requirement at their discretion to address circumstances which are beyond the Vendor's {Contractor's} control.
