Thomas Sahlin – That covers all of the official business that's on the agenda. For Matters of Information, I want to advise the board that HUD has issued a list of available waivers and other items that we are currently reviewing. We will definitely let the board know in the future and we may have to come to a vote at some point or another if we need to request or exercise any of those waivers that have been made available to us. We are also looking at other things that we could be possibly doing. The CARES did extend a little more additional funding to us for eligible expenses per HUD's definition of eligible expenses. We are looking at other services we can provide under that scope of funding. We are trying to leverage everything we have available to us to make sure that our residents do have additional resources extended to us for them. The maintenance department has been sanitizing on a more regular basis. They have been keeping up on their duties with sanitizing. Supplies have been a work in progress. We had to place several orders for a large quantity of supplies but at the time being we are doing ok. In general, the majority of our residents have been doing fine, adhering to the social distancing

recommendations but there will always be a hand full of people that don't. We've been keeping a close eye on things.
