E. Mignoli, Asbury Park Resident – Safety and Security Issues and Police Non-Response

Thomas Sahlin – To attempt to address one of your concerns, we entered into a contract with a third-party security company. We had resident security monitors in place for years. Unfortunately, with the pandemic and wanting to keep our residents safe, we had to pull them off of their posts. We did not want out residents to be on the front lines and being exposed to people coming and going. We are still in the process of getting our contractor on site. With the limitations of funding, we wish we could do more but we can't.

Vice Chair Syphax – When will the security come aboard?

Thomas Sahlin – We have a final version of the contract sent over to the contractor. There were some terms and conditions adjusted on the contract itself. Simultaneously, their project manager has been working with their HR department to pull together staffing on their side. I can't give you an exact date when they will start, but they are pulling their people together to get them on site.

Vice Chair Syphax – Will it be before the end of the month?

David Solomon – If I may, if we are going to continue talking about the Security Guard contract, I ask that we go into Executive Session.

Barbara Yarborough, Washington Village Resident- Security Guard Stipend

David Solomon – Tom, before you speak, just by the fact that you will be talking about a personnel matter, at the very least was the person speaking an employee of the Housing Authority?

Thomas Sahlin - Not in that sense, no. It was a program that was set of for residents to volunteer and they received a stipend.

David Solomon – Just by the fact that they received a stipend, I would still at the very least ask the individual speaking to wave the ability to have this matter discussed in Executive Session first before it's discussed in Public Session. The board will have the opportunity to discuss this so that her personal matters aren't being discussed for the public to view.
